
LEMOYNE STAR


Draft your design on the transparency first using a dry erase marker.




Draw a line where you want the star perimeter to be.

Make a dot at every other line where you want your star middle to end.

Remember...you can have little bottoms to your star with long star points or just the opposite. You are the boss of your star!



Now connect your dots in the middle. This creates the center of your star.




Make a dot in-between your drawn lines. This will be every other line.

Now start connecting your inside lines to the dots on the outside.

See how your star is being formed???





Once your design is drafted to your liking, take the Ultimate Stencil and place it on top of your quilt top.

Follow the same steps to draft your design on your quilt top as your did with your transparency.

This time use your quilt marking pen to draw the design...NOT the dry erase marker!!!

Remember...you can add additional points in-between the ones you just drew. You can add additional angles if you want to!
